Legislation Related to the Merger of the United Methodist Foundation of Western Pennsylvania and the Susquehanna Annual Conference UM Stewardship Foundation

Greetings in the Name of Jesus Christ! My name is Ed Bailey. In addition to my role as the Executive Director of the United Methodist Foundation of Western Pennsylvania, I have been serving as the Interim Executive of the Susquehanna Annual Conference UM Stewardship Foundation since August of 2019.

I want to thank the District Superintendent for allowing me to share for a few minutes during your District Conference about three pieces of legislation related to the Merger/Combination of our two foundations.

Three Related Resolutions

There are three related resolutions about the proposed merger/combination between the UM Foundation of Western PA and the UM Stewardship Foundation of the Susquehanna Annual Conference.

1. The first resolution is RS 707 and proposes a merger between the two Foundations. It is worth noting that both Foundations provide similar services to their respective annual conferences and are the only two United Methodist Foundations that primarily serve clientele within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

The Board of Directors of both Foundations mutually agree that joining the two organizations would provide the greatest opportunity for benefit to the churches, agencies and individuals of the Western Pennsylvania Annual Conference and the Susquehanna Annual Conference

During the due diligence period there was a significant amount of research and discovery by an independent consultant with expertise in such matters, to the satisfaction of the Merger Ad Hoc Committee consisting of directors from both Foundations.

Both Foundation Boards voted in February to combine the two organizations, with the United Methodist Foundation of Western PA being the surviving Foundation and the United Methodist Stewardship Foundation's assets, property, and other business operations joining the assets, property, and other business operations of UMFWPA.

2. The second resolution is RS 708 and proposes a plan of merger that deals with details related to the merger/combination that if approved, will be filed with Secretary of State of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. The plan contains aspects of governance that were negotiated by the leaders of both Foundations and approved by both boards. Those governance matters include the following:

- a. the Susquehanna Annual Conference shall be entitled to recommend up to one-third (1/3rd) of the directors of the UM Foundation of Western PA (keep in mind that the Western Pennsylvania Conference will continue to elect all the directors)
 - b. the UM Foundation of Western PA shall maintain a satellite office within the current geographical boundaries of the Susquehanna Annual Conference on and after the merger; and
 - c. the UM Foundation of Western PA shall have at least one full-time employee who primarily works from the satellite office located in the current geographical boundaries of the Susquehanna Annual Conference.
3. The third resolution is RS 709 and proposes changes to the Bylaws. These changes reflect matters of governance and other matters related to the merger/combination.

I want to point out three important data points related to Resolutions RS 707, RS 708, and RS 709:

First, the merger and combination of the two Foundations does not mean the two Annual Conferences are merging. The Annual Conferences are not merging because of these Resolutions. These Resolutions are related to the Foundations and not the Annual Conferences.

Second, the merged Foundation will continue to serve churches and organizations that share common bonds and convictions including various expressions of Methodism.

Third, nothing in these resolutions changes the legal relationship between the Western Pennsylvania Annual Conference and its Foundation.

I am excited about the proposed legislation related to the merger of two great Foundations. I hope my summary remarks on the proposed legislation have been helpful. If you have questions, please feel free to reach out to me at ebailey@umfoundation.org
