Rev. Sally Jo Snyder is an ordained minister in the United Methodist Church. For her first 10 years of ministry, Sally Jo was pastor to churches in Southwestern PA, New Castle, and Erie. For the last 18 years, she has served in

extension ministry, working around issues of public education, poverty, youth, seniors and persons with disabilities.

Snyder has lead advocacy work on local, regional, state and national levels. As director of advocacy for the Consumer Health Coalition, she led the Southwestern PA advocacy effort for Medicaid Expansion. She worked with persons living with behavioral health concerns and launched and directed the "Human Library Project." Snyder is a regular lecturer for Duquesne University and the University of Pittsburgh. She is a founding member of the PA Governor's Advisory Committee for Persons with Disabilities and chairs the Health Workgroup.

Rev. Snyder is a published author and an impassioned speaker. She enjoys teaching story-telling to persons who are often never asked to share their story.
